Optimist Club of Henderson Memorial Scholarship

General Information:

These scholarships are a memorial to the deceased members of the Optimist Club of Henderson whose main objective is to benefit the youth of the community. Only graduating seniors who are residents of Vance County are eligible.

Each scholarship is awarded in yearly increments of \$750.00. You may renew it annually for a maximum of three (3) more years, provided certain requirements are met. The total of the scholarship would then become a maximum of \$3,000.00.

Applications may be secured from the guidance counselor or from the Henderson Optimist Club's web site at www.henderson-optimists.org under the Scholarship section. All application materials are available in an Adobe Acrobat format. All applications, upon completion, must be submitted to the guidance counselor within the time limit as assigned by them.

Once the completed application has been submitted to the guidance counselor (with all documentation and all questions answered), the applications will be forwarded to the Scholarship Committee of the Optimist Club of Henderson for final selection and approval. The applicant will, at this time, be called for an interview with the committee.

Two scholarships will be awarded each year. Scholarships will not be assigned to any particular school within Vance County. They will be awarded on an at-large basis to the most qualified students. They are renewable annually upon:

- (1) the successful completion of a full year of higher education;
- (2) a maintained grade point average of 2.5 as evidenced by a certified copy of your transcript from that institution; and
- (3) the timely submission of your renewal application to the Optimist Club of Henderson.

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Memorial Scholarship Requirements

- 1. Applicants must be graduating seniors who are a resident of Vance County.**
- 2. Applicants must have attained at least a 2.5 grade point average combined in the junior and senior years of high school.**
- 3. Applicants must have documentation to show an equivalency score of a 2.5 grade point average upon completion of the GED examination.**
- 4. Applicants must furnish the following documentation to the scholarship committee.**
 - a. Official transcript from high school**
 - b. GED Examination score (if applicable)**
 - c. Acceptance letter from the university, college, trade school or institute of higher learning he or she plans to attend.**
- 5. Applicant must complete and obtain signatures from the individuals listed below on the Reference Request Form. (See page 6 below for the form.)**
 - a. Current Guidance Counselor or other assigned administrator**
 - b. Community member**
 - c. Employer, or not employed, a current high school teacher of the student's choice.**
- 6. Applicant must completely answer each question on the application and must submit all other documentation requested.**
- 7. Timely submission of the renewal application and requested documentation is the sole responsibility of the recipient of the scholarship. Receipt of renewal applications after July 15 will void the scholarship.**

Please Note: The Optimist Club will not issue a reminder regarding the renewal application or the deadline.

The following will apply and your signature is required as your acknowledgment of and acceptance of these rules. No exceptions will be granted.

1. Repayment of the scholarship must be made if the applicant does not complete one entire semester of higher education.
2. If the 2.5 grade point average is not maintained for each year, the recipient will not be eligible to renew the scholarship the following year.
3. Once the applicant fails to meet any one of the eligibility requirements, the scholarship will be voided. Furthermore, the scholarship may not be renewed at any point in thereafter.
4. The applicant must agree to an interview by the scholarship committee prior to the granting of the scholarship.
5. This scholarship can only be used for full time students of higher education, carrying a minimum of twelve (12) semester hours or its equivalent.
